FAURESMITH 2021 DATES

We are planning for Fauresmith 2021 to be held on the dates below and we must always adhere to COVID-19 regulations.

Ride dates: Monday 19 July 2021 to Wednesday 21 July 2021

Vet checks: Sunday 18 July 2021

Annual General Meeting: Saturday 17 July 2021 – 14h30

QUALIFICATIONS FOR FAURESMITH 2021

DATES for qualifying ride is from 1 July 2019 to 15 June 2021

Fauresmith 2019 will count as one qualifying ride.

Both rider and horse (not necessarily in combination) must successfully complete a minimum of three (3) rides of eighty (80) km or longer OR two (2) rides of hundred-twenty (120) km or longer during the period that starts on the day after the last qualifying ride for the preceding Fauresmith 200 national championships. New members to qualify 3 x 80km - these can be done via stepladder (trapleer) or competitive. The last qualifying ride must be completed in 2021.

Only COMPETITIVE MEMBERSHIP category may enter. If member has applied for non-competitive membership category the member will have to upgrade their membership to competitive.

Fauresmith is our National event and is a competitive ride, however riders will have the option after Day 1 or Day 2, once they back at the ride base and have successfully passed the vet check, to stop riding, they will sign the vet card and hand to timekeeper, once this has been done, they cannot proceed with the event. The kilometers ridden will be awarded and a certificate issued for the kilometers completed.

FAURESMITH COSTS

We are busy determining the budget to work out the fee per rider, and this will be done once negotiations with suppliers and the Fauresmith Agricultural Union have been concluded. Once these have been finalized we will advise all as soon as possible. No entry fee has been agreed or communicated.

COVID-19 regulations

Please be aware that all people at the venue will have to respect and adhere to all COVID-19 Protocols, at all times. If the country should be placed in a higher lockdown level by Government, restricting moving or cross border travel or any other rules that will prevent riders to attend the ride, or that the Fauresmith ride will be cancelled, this is then out of ERASA's hands.
